Green Waste Collection

The last pickup date for Green Waste Collections for Magna will be Monday, December 4th. We remind residents not to place the green cans out on the curb after that date. They will not be picked up nor emptied. Collections for green waste will resume the week of March 11, 2024. Thank you to all our loyal supporters!



WFWRD Board Approves 2024 Budget

WFWRD will not be implementing a fee increase for base services in 2024. However, there are some changes that will be implemented for the Town of Brighton and Big Cottonwood Canyon residents:

- Town of Brighton and Big Cottonwood Canyon Residents will receive an increase in the amount of \$2.00 per month to \$18.00 per month for full-time and \$11.75 for seasonal.
- Increase the fees associated with front-load container/dumpster collections by 10% for garbage and 18% for recycling; and various fee increases associated with non-residential services and special events.

WFWRD’s Board of Trustees held a Public Hearing on Monday, November 13, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. to allow public comment for the Tentative 2024 Budget. After the close of the Public Hearing with no comments from the public, the Board approved the 2024 Budget and Fee Schedule.

Curbside Christmas Tree Collection

We will be collecting Christmas trees during the month of January. For collection, fill out a Curbside Tree Pick Up Request Form on our website (www.wasatchfrontwaste.org), or call the WFWRD office at (385) 468-6325. Place your undecorated trees on your curb and they will be collected the day after your regular collection day during the month of January. If we don’t get your tree that week, we will be back the following week. Please call our office, or chat with us on our website for additional information.



- Please remove all snow off the tree.
- We cannot accept trees with decorations, lights, tree stands or flocking.
- Do not place the tree in your garbage, recycling, or green waste can.
- If the tree is over eight feet tall, please cut it into smaller sections.
- We cannot accept artificial trees.
